Yet, what is even more disturbing than this administration's deceit is the silence and paralysis of the world in the face of such open aggression. The recent U.S. operation, dubbed 'Operation Midnight Hammer', is not a testament to American strength — it is a humiliating exposure of the political impotence and disunity that plague the Muslim Ummah. Not because the Ummah lacks the means to stand up for its rights — but because the will is scattered across fractured borders, ruled by regimes more concerned with preserving their own thrones and loyal to Washington's interests rather than to their own people.
