The Birth of Guidance: A Light That Dispels the Darkness of Existence

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The planet Earth, and particularly the Arabian Peninsula, was living in total darkness that made human life resemble hell. Indeed, the birth of the Prophet (saw), his mission, and his victory to establish the Deen, were rays of a great light that illuminated the Earth. It is truly an obligation upon us to bring this light back to the Earth once again by restoring its torchbearer and spreader of brilliance—the Khilafah (Caliphate).
