2023 Khilafah Conference

Chicago, May 13th, 2023 – Hizb ut Tahrir / America successfully conducted its annual Khilafah Conference. This year's conference—titled "Crises & Crossroads: The Urgency of Islam to Save the World"— centered around the themes of family, economy, and the political state of our society steeped in crisis and standing at crossroads. The conference provided critical insights into the present social issues challenging the Muslim family to the economic and political crises exposing America's state of affairs. The conference began with reciting the Quran Al-Kareem, then followed by an engaging talk by Brother Zaki Tahir, providing an in-depth understanding of the challenges the Muslim community faces from the increasing pressure from the LGBTQ and feminist agenda. His speech offered practical strategies to help Muslim families protect their children, empowering them to resist the fahisha attempting to destroy the Muslim family.
